## Human Hazards

Hazard type	Who may be harmed	Is the risk adequately controlled
General – All Hazards	All Participants & Staff	Appropriately trained Surrey Outdoor Learning and Development (S.O.L.D) staff to facilitate ensuring supervision of participants. All participants to be briefed clearly on task and how to safely achieve the aim. See 'general' risk assessment for S.O.L.D. centre.
Falling/slipping	All Participants & Staff	Safety brief before each game. Staff to check area prior to session and remove any tripping / slipping hazards present.
Personal injury	All Participants & Staff	Group briefed prior to activity. S.O.L.D. staff to supervise games that have potential for contact.

## **Environment Hazards**

Hazard type	Who may be harmed	Is the risk adequately controlled
Injury to feet and hands	All Participants & Staff	Check the area prior to use. Activity to be run on grass.
Entrapment	All Participants & Staff	Safety brief given. S.O.L.D. staff to supervise at all times.
Entrapment	All Participants	Safety brief given on entrapment if sitting with legs under seats or in air pocket of upturned canoe. Rafted canoes must use appropriate equipment. Rafting using painters is not allowed to stop "clamshelling".
Collision with other vessels	All Participants & Staff	S.O.L.D staff appropriately trained to deal with situation.
